Long Sutton Flag

The eagle-eyed amongst you will have noticed the Long Sutton flag flying from the flag-pole at the Village Hall. Footpaths

Long Sutton is so lucky to have such an extensive footpath network throughout the village.

We are also indebted to Rich Fell and Dick Shepherd who maintain the footpaths as volunteers, and with the support of our landowners, try to keep the network in tiptop condition.

The Parish Council has a good track record of working with our landowners, but we all have a responsibility to not only keep the footpaths in usable condition, but to also adhere to the Countryside Code when using the network – <u>www.countryside-code.org.uk</u>. Landowners get frustrated when walkers don't shut gates, don't stick to the footpath, or do not keep their dogs on leads that then disturb livestock or finally, do not pick up their dog's poo, which if inhaled or ingested by ovine or bovine animals can kill them.

The Council, in conjunction with Somerset Council and some of the landowners, has invested in maintaining the network and will continue to do so with a rolling programme of work. With this in mind we need help from our community. Firstly, to report an issue with the footpath network that you think needs addressing,

please email the Parish Clerk, ideally with a reference point, footpath number or photograph, and then most importantly, if you would like to join the band of volunteers supporting Rich & Dick then we would also like to hear from you by emailing clerk@longsuttonpc.gov.uk or 07561695671

Parishioners whose properties adjoin the road, lane or pavement are reminded that greenery from the hedge should not overhang onto the public highway or path. As the summer growth has exploded since the midsummer rains, the overhanging has become a real issue around the village so the Parish Council reminds those with this issue to cut back over-flowing foliage as a matter of urgency as you could be legally responsible for any accident caused by any overhanging material from your property that might cause an accident. If you do not have the time or inclination to undertake such work, please get in touch with the Parish Council who can recommend local businesses to undertake the work for you.
